THE SPEAKERS AND THEIR TOPICS

MICKEY ANN HINOJOSA is Internet Services Coordinator at SOLINET, responsible for training, support, and development. Her Internet seminars and courses are widely offered throughout the southeast as part of SOLINET's Continuing Education and Training Program. Topic: Library Stops Along the Information Superhighway: SOLINET & OCLC.

PATRICIA A. LANGELIER is with the Institute of Government at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. She was instrumental in getting legislation passed in 1987 which established the statewide network of depository libraries to make state government publications accessible to North Carolina citizens. Ms. Langelier continues to be active in strategic planning for the state as the "author" of an Internet gopher and through her involvement in the development of a World Wide Web server. Topic: The Impact of Librarians on the Information Superhighway.

CLIFFORD A. LYNCH is the Director of the Division of Automation, Office of the President, at the University of California. He is responsible for the MELVYL information system, and is involved in a wide variety of projects in the application of technology to information management, including computer networking, information servers, and imaging technologies. Dr. Lynch is a frequent speaker at national library events. Topic: The Future of Library Education.

VANCE K. OPPERMAN is the president of West Publishing Company and former senior partner in the law firm of Opperman, Heins & Pacquin. He was named one of the 100 "most influential lawyers in America" and one of the top ten litigators by the National Law Journal. Mr. Opperman is one of the 25 delegates to the National Information Infrastructure Advisory Council. Topic: An Update on the Negotiations and Progress of the NII Advisory.

SCOTT SMITH is president and publisher of the Ft. Lauderdale Sun Sentinel, and a member of the Executive Board of America Online. Topic: The Information Superhighway and the Mass Media.

MARY SOMERVILLE, the Director of the Miami-Dade Public Library System, is one of two candidates for American Library Association president for 1996/97. She oversaw the massive reconstruction and reopening efforts of four libraries destroyed by Hurricane Andrew. Ms. Somerville has served as project manager and coordinator for automation, and for children's, youth, and special services in the Broward County (FL) Library System, in Louisville, KY, and Lincoln, NE. She will be giving the opening remarks.


